WOMEN'S MARCH 2018

The 2018 Women's March, held on January 20, on the anniversary of the 2017 Women's March, was a reprise protest march with coordinated mass rallies, attracting hundreds of thousands of participants, in hundreds of cities, towns and suburbs in the United States, with sister rallies in Canada, the UK, Japan, Italy and other countries. Some of the largest rallies in the United States were held in New York, Washington, Los Angeles, Dallas, Philadelphia, Chicago, San Francisco, and Atlanta. In addition to women's rights, worker's rights, equality, unity, and ending violence, new themes have surfaced such as immigration and environmental rights. Another new theme this year gaining momentum is "Power to the Polls". Power to the Polls carries a new message with a focus on increasing voter participation through new voter registrations, encouraging more women, as "strong advocates for women's rights", to run for office.
