Captain Lee Ann Holroyd
Inspector General, Commander of Professional Standards, School Security and the Key West International Airport
Lee Ann Holroyd, who grew up in the Keys and graduated Coral Shores High School, is a member of the law enforcement field, serving the public and law enforcement community for more than 35 years. She is currently a Captain in the school security Standards, School Security and the Key West International Airport with the MS201 as the lead investigator in an effort to return seized assets to benefit the community and service. Lee Ann holds a Bachelor's Degree in Criminal Justice Administration and a Master's Degree in Forensic Psychology and Criminal Justice from University of Cincinnati.

Patricia J. Thompson
Director, School Safety and Security Monroe County Sheriff's Office
A former firefighter/EMT and Ohio State Trooper, Ms. Thompson served as a Special Agent in Charge in the FBI, where she worked in the Miami and Los Angeles Field Divisions, working on high-profile cases, including a robbery/homicide case, public corruption, and crimes against children. Ms. Thompson was the first female member of the FBI's SWAT Team and the first female in the history of the FBI to train and certify as a SWAT sniper.

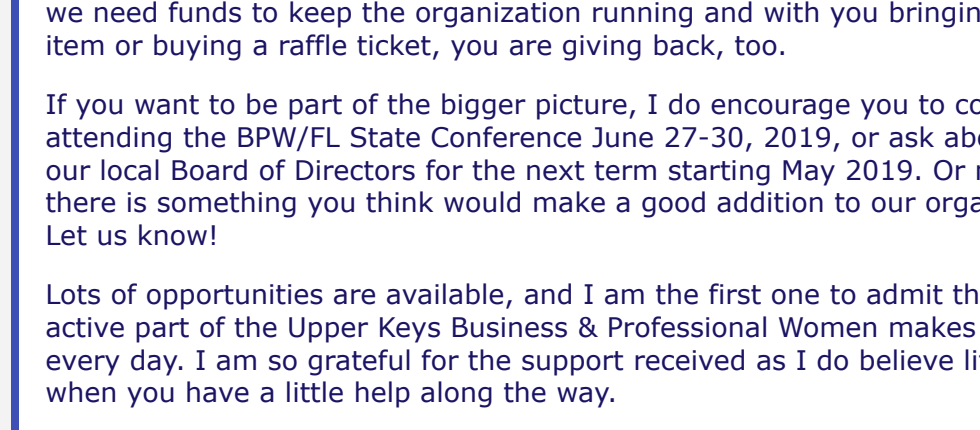
Among Ms. Thompson's many awards, the most notable is that she is the recipient of the FBI Director's Award for Outstanding Contributions in Law Enforcement for her investigative case work on a large scale RICO operation. They were also a finalist for the FBI Director's Award for Exceptional Heroism as a result of a foot pursuit for a homicide suspect in a case that was featured on America's Most Wanted.

Throughout her career, Patty has provided training to FBI Agents as well as state and local law enforcement officers throughout the U.S., Europe, and the Middle East. She is the owner of VESTIGES Key West, and serves as Adjunct Faculty for the University of Tennessee Law Enforcement Innovation Center, and the Ocala Academy of International Security Studies (OAISS).

Lee Ann has been a member of BPW since 2012. She is active in the community and serves on the boards of the Chi Sigma chapter of Beta Sigma Phi, Central's Courage Rape Crisis Center, MAFAC (Monroe Association of Female/Black Citizens) and Monroe County State of Hope Foundation. She loves serving our community both professionally and as a volunteer, and enjoys being a wife and mother. Feeling blessed to live in such an amazing and giving community.

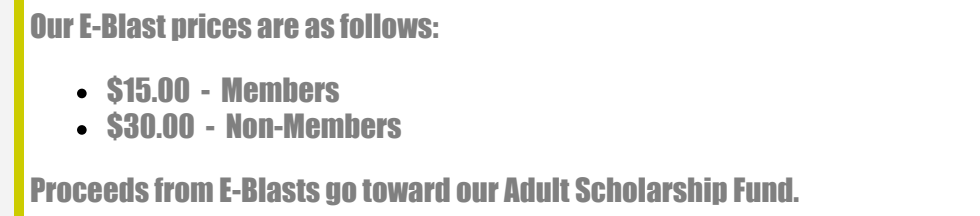
